Our facility is fully-equipped with the latest in advanced technology monitoring and communication devices to ensure our patients receive optimum care with minimal discomfort.

Our clinicians use ultrasound imaging for PICC placement and central venous access thereby increasing access success rates and reducing the risk of complications due to puncture or irritation.

All of our patients are fitted with a ViSi mobile device for continuous vital signs monitoring – and the stats are transmitted directly to our central nursing station, which improves our patients' safety.

We Deliver Superior Care.

The Premier Point AIC nursing staff has an average of 10 years of infusion experience, and is certified in the safe delivery of complex and chronic types of infusion therapy including Chemotherapy, IVIG, and IV Antibiotics to patients as young as one-year old.

We also have Spanish-speaking clinicians on staff allowing for the delivery of full care and follow up instructions in Spanish.

Following treatment, patients are educated on signs and symptoms of drug toxicity and other adverse events, and given contact information for 24 hour access to a nurse who can answer questions pertaining to their specific treatment plan.

The Premier Point team is dedicated to promoting optimal health outcomes from our infusion therapy. To support that commitment, our nurses are required to attend quarterly training seminars on new techniques and drugs available for antimicrobial administration – one additional step in ensuring their skill levels exceed industry standards.
